

EMBA (Blended Mode) Admission Policy 2022

This document summarizes the approach of IIM Jammu to prepare the admission list for its EMBA (Blended Mode) Batch 2022-24. The batch size is likely to be around 90. IIM Jammu reserves the right to modify any part of this document including the various criteria and cut offs mentioned at any time till the actual admission process for the batch is completed.

Selection Process

The selection process of IIM Jammu consists of:

- Test Score - CAT/GMAT/GRE score or IIM Jammu Admission Test (IIMJAT) Score
 - Academic Profile –Graduation Score/percentage
 - Personal Interview
 - Preparation of Merit list will be based on CAT/GMAT/GRE/IIMJAT Score, academic profile, gender diversity, and personal interview
 - The candidates with CAT/GMAT/GRE score obtained during the past three years may be exempted from the IIMJAT 2022. The past three years would be counted from the last date of the application.

- IIM Jammu strictly follows the Government of India's Reservation Policy

Eligibility

- Work Experience: Candidates should have at least three years of work experience till the last date of application. Experience earned during the study period will not be considered.
- Educational Qualifications:

A Bachelor's Degree with minimum aggregate marks of 50% for General, 47% for NC - OBC, and 45% for SC/ST/DAP awarded by recognised University/educational institution or possess an equivalent qualification recognised by the Ministry of Education, Government of India or alternately should have completed professional programs like CA/CS/ICWA.

Criteria for Preparing the Merit List

- Criteria for preparing the merit list will be based on the composite score comprising the weightage of CAT/GMAT/GRE/IIMJAT score, the academic profile of graduation, work experience, gender diversity, and personal interview as follows:

Offer Acceptance Fee and Withdrawal

After the declaration of the merit list, candidates will be asked to register for the expression of the interest. The candidates who will successfully register in the expression of interest will receive the admission offer as per the vacant seat and his/her order in the merit list. A candidate receiving admission offer from IIM Jammu and accepting the offer within the stipulated date needs to send along with Offer Acceptance, an Offer Acceptance Amount of Rs.50,000/-. If a candidate registers for the program, his/her Offer Acceptance Amount will be adjusted against Term I Fee. If a candidate subsequently wishes to withdraw the offer within the withdrawal date specified by the Institute, Offer Acceptance Amount will be refunded after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as processing charges. If a candidate applies for withdrawal after the date specified by the Institute, no refund will be admissible. In the event of withdrawal from the Program after registration, no refund of offer acceptance amount & Semester Fee will be made.

Any dispute concerning Admissions for the EMBA Batch 2022 would be subject to jurisdiction of the competent courts within the territorial jurisdiction of city of Jammu Only.

EMBA (Blended Mode) Fee Structure

The program fee for resident Indians for the two years of the EMBA (Blended Mode) would be INR 8,85,000/- (Rupees eight lakh and eighty-five thousand only) plus immersion fee, if a candidate opts for that, on actual expenditure basis. The details are:

The candidate has to deposit one-time refundable caution money of Rs. 20,000/- along with the Term-I fee. The program fee includes access to synchronous online lectures, on-campus lectures, access to the academic facilities and the cost of the boarding during the on-campus module, and it excludes the cost of the immersion program.

Participation in the immersion program (Global/Rural) is optional

Fee Concessions of 20% for Indian military and paramilitary forces and 10% for CA/CS/ICWA members is given subject to submission of relevant documents.
