IIM Jammu's First Batch of MBA Hospital Administration and Healthcare Management (HA & HM) Achieves 100% Placements: A Landmark Achievement



JAMMU, April 4, 2024 - IIM Jammu announced the final placement results for the first batch of its MBA in Hospital Administration and Healthcare Management (2022-24), conducted in collaboration with AIIMS Jammu and IIT Jammu. Under the leadership of Director Prof. B.S. Sahay, the placement season saw participation from over 56 companies, marking a significant milestone for the rapidly growing institute.

All 44 students from the inaugural batch secured positions in various domains including Healthcare Sector, Product Management, Marketing, Consulting, Finance, General Management, Operations, and Supply Chain related to Healthcare and Health Administration. The highest domestic CTC was INR 32 LPA, with the top 10 percentile at 21.7 LPA, and the average top quartile CTC at INR 18.76 LPA. The average and median CTC stood at INR 14.01 LPA and 13 LPA, respectively.



Analysing barriers to humanitarian logistics for distributing relief aid in pre- and post-disaster situations

Abstract: The purpose of this paper is to analyse key challenges in implementing the relief measures of humanitarian logistics (HL) in the pre- and post-occurrence of the disaster. Analysing the severity of barriers to humanitarian logistics assists decision-makers and policymakers in reducing societal vulnerability and ensuring efficient allocation of resources in a disastrous environment. An integrated decision-making framework comprising Grey-Delphi and Grey-DEMATEL is employed based on the survey results obtained from various experts and stakeholders in humanitarian logistics. A recent natural calamity that happened in the state of Assam, India, has been selected as a viable case study for the study. Existing barriers to HL have been identified from the prior literature. The factors are further validated by the practitioners and experts in the case context using the Grey-Delphi technique. Further, the causalprominence relation between HL barriers is revealed by using the Grey-DEMATEL tool. The findings of the study suggest that obsolete IT infrastructure, inconsistent quality monitoring procedures of the relief aids, uncertain and complex geographical conditions, failure of early warning systems, difficulties in last-mile deliveries, and poor coordination among stakeholders serve as critical factors that hinder the efficient functioning of humanitarian logistics in the Indian context. Several managerial and theoretical implications are based on the findings of the study.

Abstract: The study aims to determine the role of online retail website experience on brand happiness and willingness to share personal information using the theoretical lens of the Stimulus-Organism-Response (SOR) framework. Further, it explores the role of brand intimacy and brand partner quality in mediating the path between brand happiness and willingness to share personal information.

The present study found that online retail website experience is significantly related to brand happiness. The finding also supports that brand happiness was positively and significantly related to 'consumers' willingness to share personal information. This relationship was fully mediated by brand intimacy. Brand happiness also mediated the relationship between website experience and the willingness to share personal information.

Does ESG disclosure really influence the firm performance? Evidence from India

Abstract: In this paper, we examine the influence of ESG disclosure scores on firm performance of companies listed in the National Stock Exchange (NSE). The study uses 167 sample firms from 2010 to 2020. We capitalise overall ESG disclosure scores taken as a proxy to measure the effect of sustainability disclosure on firm performance.

Further, we consider the return on assets (ROA), return on equity (ROE), Tobin's Q, and Price Earnings ratio (P/E ratio) as firm performance measures. We employ dynamic panel data regression analysis to examine the influence of ESG disclosures on the performance of the firm. In order to address the endogeneity issues, we apply Generalised Method of Moments (GMM) model. The study results show a positive relationship between ESG disclosure and firm performance. It suggests that companies' desire to enhance their performance need to pay more attention towards sustainability disclosures.
