

Entrepreneurship orientation program concludes at IIM Jammu

JAMMU, Jan 30: Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Jammu concluded the entrepreneurship orientation training program of the first batch of forty students from various colleges under the Department of Higher Education, here today.

Prof BS Sahay, Director, IIM Jammu inaugurated the program on January 24. The program was divided into five sub-themes focusing on Business Idea Creation, Strategic Planning and Design, Finance for Entrepreneurs, Marketing for Entrepreneurs and Teams' Management and Communication.
